Structure of the Language

Grammar:

- ✓ The interrogative and impersonal forms
- ✓ Conjugate the verbs "avoir" (to have) and "être" (to be) at the present tense
- Conjugate some common verbs for the first group (verbs which infinitive ends with -er) at the present tense (only with singular subjects)
- Conjugate a few verbs from the third group like "peindre" (to paint), "boire" (to drink), "prendre" (to take), "apprendre" (to learn), "mettre" (to put on), to learn, "faire" to do, "pondre" to lay eggs, "devoir" to have to, "pouvoir" can, "connaître" to know, at the at the present tense (only singular subjects)
- ✓ Gender agreement of adjectives
- ✓ The imperative form and its negative form
- ✓ It is/they are + article + noun
- ✓ I like/I don't like + verb and I like/I don't like + article + noun
- ✓ Verbs at the negative form
- ✓ Spatial prepositions (under, in, on...)
- ✓ Être (to be) + adjective
- ✓ Avoir mal au/à la/aux + nom (Structure to express that a specific body part is hurting)
- ✔ Partitives
- ✓ I would like + infinitive verb / I would like + partitive + noun
- ✓ To prefer + article + noun
- ✓ Adverbs to express quantities (a lot, a few, not at all, without)
- ✓ Impersonal expressions to talk about the weather
- ✔ Prepositions used with transportations (à/en)
- ✓ I live at + address, I live in + country
- ✓ Aller + au/à la/à l' (to go to) Jouer au/à la/du/de la
- ✓ Interrogative pronouns (where, how many/how much, when)
- ✓ Interrogative adjectives (quel, quelle, quelle, quelles which/what)
- ✓ Comparison with "comme" (like)
- ✔ Progressive present
- ✓ Near futur
- ✓ Common expressions with the verb "avoir" (to have)
- ✓ To want + verb at the infinitive form
- ✓ The interdiction with negative infinitive

Communication Structures/Themes (student is able to)

- Greet and say goodbye
- ✓ Say what time it is, the day of the week, the date of the day
- ✓ Ask and say his/her name and age and nationality
- ✓ Talk about his/her activities and other persons'
- ✓ Express his/her tastes and preferences, his/her emotions
- ✓ Give his/her address
- ✓ Describe his/her city, town, or neighborhood
- ✓ Locate himself/herself in space
- ✓ Describe someone physically, and mentally
- ✓ Introduce his/her close family then describe his/her extended family
- ✓ Describe the pet he/she has
- ✓ Name some countries
- ✓ Describe his/her classroom
- ✓ Talk about subjects studied in school and name school supplies used in class
- Use temporal conjunctions
- ✓ Pay with euros
- ✓ Use a few idiomatic expressions
- ✓ Describe some animals and their habits
- ✓ Count up to 1,000
- ✓ Name a few rooms of the house, and some objects in his/her bedroom
- ✓ Name body parts, and features of the face
- ✓ Name a few food items, and drinks
- ✓ Name some clothes
- ✓ Talk about the weather
- ✓ Talk about holidays and travel, plan a trip

Language Proficiency (student is able to)

Listening Comprehension:

- ✓ Understand public announcements, and standard recorded messages
- ✓ Understand regular instructions
- Understand a recorded message about a theme studied in class
- ✓ Understand a simple description

Reading Comprehension:

- ✓ Recognize some names, words, or expressions of his/her daily life
- ✓ Find data, proper nouns, and very simple information in a short text
- ✓ Identify the purpose of a few ordinary texts he/she will encounter in his/her daily or school life
- ✓ Understand a personal message, a postcard, a short text
- ✓ Find data in a simple document
- Understand a simple description
- ✓ Find information on a poster, an ad
- ✓ Find data in a simple document: description, poster, ad, short article...

Speaking

- Greet and say goodbye
- ✓ Introduce himself/herself (name, age, origin, language, address)
- ✓ Talk about himself/herself and his/her activities
- ✓ Answer simple questions
- Accept and refuse
- ✓ Ask someone how he/she is doing, and react to the answer
- ✓ Ask something politely
- ✓ Adapt his/her language according to the situation (formal/informal)
- Describe an event, what people are doing, and where they are

Writing:

- ✓ Write numbers and the date of the day
- ✔ Recognize different kinds of written forms (script, cursive...)
- ✓ Write personal information in a form: name, nationality, address, age, birth date
- Write a brief message containing one or two sentences to describe his/her activities
- ✓ Write on imaginary characters in a context studied in class
- ✓ Write a coherent text using very simple transition words
